



# Brown County Board Minutes

July 20, 2021

The Brown County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, at 5:15 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse meeting room with members Chairman Raymond Small and Reagan Wiebelhaus present. Dennis Bauer was absent with an excused absence. Also present were Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travee Hobbs, Brown County Highway Superintendent Kenneth Turpin (BCHS), Brown County Attorney (CA) Andy Taylor and Brown County Treasurer (BCT) Deb Vonheeder.

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance to the Meeting Room.

Those in attendance rose and stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner meeting was recessed at 5:15 PM in order to continue the BOE protest hearings.

The meeting reconvened at 5:36 PM

Small moved to approve minutes from the June 15, 2021 Special Commissioner Meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Small moved to approve minutes from the July 6, 2021 Commissioner Meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

The Board discussed resolutions establishing funds for the Wireless 911.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2021-33 establishing Funds 2913 Wireless 911 Fund for the day to day expenses related to Wireless 911 services, 2914 Wireless 911 Holding Fund for the purchase of equipment related to Wireless 911 services. Small seconded. Roll Call: Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2021-34 transferring \$8,000.00 from the Inheritance Tax Fund to the Wireless 911 Fund. Small seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Small moved to approve Resolution #2021-35 transferring \$140,000.00 from the Inheritance Tax Fund to the Disaster Recovery Fund. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

The Board acknowledged Fund 4600 Capital Projects/Meadville Avenue.

The Board acknowledged Fund 3700 Meadville Ave Bond payments.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve the claims and the Sheriff's monthly fee report for July of \$355.30. Small seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

BCHS Turpin gave a Road Department report.

The Board acknowledged the Brown County Agriculture Society, Brown County Rural Fire & Ainsworth Public Library Budget requests.

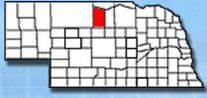
The Board acknowledged the Brown County Ambulance roster.
