



Brown County Board Minutes

January 4, 2022

The Brown County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, January 4, 2022, at 5:15 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse meeting room with members Chairman Buddy Small, Reagan Wiebelhaus and Dennis Bauer present. Also present were Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travis Hobbs and Brown County Attorney (BCA) Andy Taylor.

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance to the Meeting Room.

Those in attendance rose and stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Small moved to approve minutes from the December 21, 2021 Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

BCHS Turpin was not present but left a written Road Department report which Chairman Small read aloud.

Small gave an update on the Sand Draw Creek Bridge project. Nebraska Department of Transportation will advertise for Bids on January 18, 2022 and will open them on February 10, 2022. A bid for the project should be awarded on or about February 17, 2022.

The Board discussed the resolution setting the salaries for the January 2023 – January 2027 official terms that were decided during the December 21, 2021 commissioner meeting.

Small moved to approve Resolution #2022-1 setting salaries for the January 2023 – January 2027 official terms. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve the claims, Brown County Sheriff's corrected monthly fee reports for the month of September 2021 of \$210.17, month of October 2021 of \$342.97 and month of November 2021 of \$648.23 and the Brown County Clerks' monthly fee report for December 2021 of \$4,548.48 as presented. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

Public comments were heard.
