June 21, 2022

The Brown County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 5:19 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse meeting room with members Vice Chairman Dennis Bauer and Reagan Wiebelhaus present. Member Buddy Small was absent with an excused absence. Also present were Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travis Hobbs, Brown County Attorney (BCA) Andy Taylor and Brown County Highway Superintendent (BCHS) Kenneth Turpin.

Vice Chairman Bauer acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance to the Meeting Room.

Those in attendance rose and stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve minutes from the June 7, 2022, Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Bauer Aye, and Small Absent, motion carried.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve the minutes from the June 13, 2022, Special Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: Bauer Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Small Absent, motion carried.

BCHS Kenneth Turpin updated the Board with road department projects.

At 5:30 PM the Public Hearing for the Brown County Budget Amendment was opened.

Discussion was held regarding the LB644 Post Card Bill requirements.

Wiebelhaus moved to work with the Nebraska Administrative print shop for the LB644 postcards printing. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: Bauer Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Small Absent, motion carried.

Brown County Ambulance Association members Ann Fiala, Darlene Miller and Scott Goodloe discussed housing for their ambulances and the Brown County Ambulance Budget.

The Board acknowledged the IRS mileage rate increase to \$.625, effective July 1, 2022, for the remainder of 2022.

North Central Development Center (NCDC) Executive Director, Kristin Olson presented the Board with the proposed NCDC 2022-2023 Budget. The Board pledged \$10,000.00 for the budget year.

BCA Taylor discussed two Foreclosure Tax Sale Certificates.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2022-26 and #2022-27 directing and authorizing to foreclose tax sale certificates #2501 & #2502. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Bauer Aye and Small Absent, motion carried.

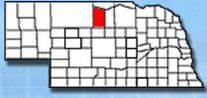
BCA Taylor presented the Board with a County Burial Application.
