

Brown County Board Minutes

July 5, 2022

The Brown County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 5:19 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse meeting room with members Chairman Buddy Small, Dennis Bauer and Reagan Wiebelhaus present. Also present were Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travis Hobbs and Brown County Highway Superintendent (BCHS) Kenneth Turpin.

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance to the Meeting Room.

Those in attendance rose and stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bauer moved to approve minutes from the June 21, 2022, Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Bauer Aye, and Small Abstain, motion carried.

Randy Priest presented a proposed Approval of Subdivision – Bowen – Priest, part of the NW1/4NW1/4 of Section 11, Township 27, Range 22 lying North and East of the County Road.

Small moved to approve the subdivision as described. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

The Board discussed appointing two new members to the Brown County Safety Committee.

Small moved to approve Resolution #2022-30 appointing Scott Erthum and Kurt Starkey as members to the Brown County Safety Committee. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

BCHS Kenneth Turpin updated the Board with road department projects.

The Board met with the Ainsworth City Council to discuss the funding options for the Sandhills Care Center. No action taken.

BCHS Turpin presented a Preliminary Engineering Services Supplemental Agreement No. 2 between Brown County & Miller & Associates Inc.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2022-31 Preliminary Engineering Services Supplemental Agreement No. 2 between Brown County & Miller & Associates Inc. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

BCC Hobbs discussed a potential update to the County website and funding options. No action taken.

The Board acknowledged the Brown County Audit prepared by Ritterbush and Piotrowski LLP.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2022-32 a transfer of \$250,00.00 from Miscellaneous General in the General Fund to County Highway Fund. Small seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve Resolution #2022-33 a transfer of \$3,000.00 from Miscellaneous General in the General Fund to Reappraisal Fund. Small seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.

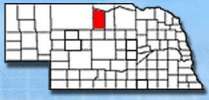
Small moved to approve the claims. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.
