



# Brown County Board Minutes

October 4, 2022

The Brown County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at 5:15 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse meeting room with members Chairman Buddy Small and Reagan Wiebelhaus present. Member Dennis Bauer was absent with an approved absence. Also present was Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travis Hobbs.

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance to the Meeting Room.

Those in attendance rose and stated the Pledge of Allegiance.

Small moved to approve minutes from the September 20, 2022, Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Small moved to approve minutes from the three September 19, 2022, Special Commissioner meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 23. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

BCHS Kenneth Turpin was not present, Small gave a brief update of the road department projects.

Small moved to approve Resolution #2022-45 signing the Annual Certification of Program Compliance and Signing Resolution with the Nebraska Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards (NBCS). Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Ed Knott and Will Zoucha with Applied Connective Technologies, Albion, Nebraska presented a quote for cybersecurity/IT services for the County Attorney and County Clerk's offices, Courthouse WiFi and a modernized phone system. After discussion, the County will seek additional informal bids as the amount meets the bidding requirement threshold.

No bids were submitted for prisoner meals.

Discussion was had on purchasing an air purification system.

Small moved to purchase 10 I Wave air purifier filtration systems at a cost of \$5,200.00 from Greg's Heating and Air, Bassett, Nebraska. Wiebelhaus seconded. Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Small moved to approve Resolution #2022- 46 transferring \$350,000.00 from Miscellaneous General within the General Fund to the County Highway Fund. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Small Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

Small moved to approve payment of the claims. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Wiebelhaus Aye, Small Aye and Bauer Absent, motion carried.

No Public comments were made.
