The Brown County Commissioners met for a public hearing on Tuesday, September 19, 2023, at 1:30 P.M., in the Brown County Courthouse Meeting room with members Chairman Buddy Small, Dennis Bauer and Jeremiah Dailey present. Also present were Brown County Clerk Travis Hobbs (BCC) and Brown County Attorney Andy Taylor (BCA).

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the entrance of the Meeting Room.

Chairman Small stated the purpose of the hearing.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear support, opposition, criticism, suggestions, or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed 2023-2024 budget on file in the County Clerk's office.
