The Brown County Commissioners met as the Board of Equalization (BOE) in regular session on Tuesday, June 1, 2021, at 5:00 P.M., Brown County Courthouse meeting room with Chairman Buddy Small, Reagan Wiebelhaus and Dennis Bauer present. Also present were Brown County Clerk, Travis Hobbs (BCC) and Brown County Assessor, Terri Van Houten (BCA).

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the door.

Small moved to approve the minutes of the regular May 18, 2021 BOE meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes. Motion carried.

The Board discussed setting protest hearing dates.

The Board set July 6, 2021 at 1:00 pm, July 8, 2021 at 1:00 pm and July 15th at 1:00 pm for 2021 protest hearings.

BCA Van Houten presented the Board with two homestead exemptions where one was denied and the percentage changed on the second.

Wiebelhaus moved to approve the two tax list corrections #37 & #38 as presented by BCA Terri Van Houten and authorize Chairman Small to sign. Bauer seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.
