The Brown County Commissioners met as the Board of Equalization (BOE) in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 5:00 P.M., Brown County Courthouse meeting room with Chairman Buddy Small, Dennis Bauer and Reagan Wiebelhaus present. Also present were Brown County Clerk (BCC) Travis Hobbs and Brown County Assessor (BCA) Terri Van Houten.

Chairman Small acknowledged the Open Meeting Act posted near the door.

Bauer moved to approve the minutes of the regular June 21, 2022, BOE meeting as written and officially recorded in Commissioner Book 22. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: Bauer Aye, Wiebelhaus Aye, and Small Abstain, motion carried.

Small discussed the 3-Year Plan of Assessment and making some additions. No action taken. The item was placed on the next agenda.

At 5:05 P.M. the Public Hearing for Tax exemption applications for the Ainsworth Church of the Nazarene and Ainsworth Childcare Center was opened.

The hearing was closed at 5:15 P.M.

Bauer moved to approve the permissive exemption applications for the Ainsworth Church of the Nazarene and Ainsworth Child Care Center and authorize Chairman Small to sign. Wiebelhaus seconded. Roll Call: All three Ayes, motion carried.
